Su Eaton is an artist, musician, shadow puppeteer and performer. She has worked with her partner Martin Bridle as Hand to Mouth Theatre since meeting at Art College in the 1970s. She began by playing music, drumming up the crowd and "bottling" (collecting the money) for Martin's traditional Punch and Judy show on the beaches of South East England, and has been a key part of the visual design, the music, publicity and general creation of many original puppet shows since then.

She has illustrated books for children (incuding "Punch and Judy in the Rain") and combined her illustrative and performance skills to presents her solo shadow puppet shows and workshops in schools and theatres, as well as performing as a duo with Martin.

She learnt to play the hurdy-gurdy (Zanfona) to accompany their medieval style show "Piggery Jokery" which has travelled the world - from Taiwan and South Korea to the USA and Canada - and the use of this ancient instrument has become a key element in many of their shows.

Su worked at The Puppet Centre in London, in the 1980s, and was a jury member of the Arlyn Award for Puppet Design in 2020.
